


# What is the key value proposition of your initiative? (per country)














# What business model types are the most used by different types of legal entities?






#### Which subjects are members of the initiative?






#### Which members of the initiative have voting rights?






#### How are voting rights allocated?






#### What governing and organizational structures does the initiative have?

# **Key takeaways**

- Social aspect is not key motivation of the initiatives
- Most initiatives uses the "registered cooperative" model
- Within registered cooperatives, CSC residential, generation & trading and energy services: mobility are the most used business model types
- Natural persons (consumers and prosumers) outnumber other types of members of the inititives
- Important number of intiatives include local authorities and private companies, not many of them inlude public comapnies (utilities)
- Most of the initiatives declared rather democratic decision-making process ("one member, one vote rule")






